 this my Present Last Will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say) First & principally
 I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping thro. the Merits, Death & Passion of my
 Saviour Jesus Christ to have full & free Pardon & forgiveness of all my Sins & to inherit everlasting life
 And my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter
 Named And as touching the disposition of all such temporal Estates which it hath pleased Almighty God
 to bestow upon me, I give and dispose thereof as fo'll.

I Will that all my Debts & Funeral Charges be paid and Discharged

I Give and bequeath unto my Son John Sledge one breeding Year.

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca Twie one breeding Year

I Give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Judith Ellison two pewter dishes to be delivered to her
 when she Attains the Age of twenty one years or Married.

All the rest & residue of my Estate, Goods & Chattells whatsoever I do give & bequeath unto my Daughter
 Martha Hay & her heirs.

And I do Order & Appoint my Son in Law Peter Hay full & Sole Execut^r of this my Last Will and
 Testament desiring my Estate may not be Appraised. And I do hereby revoke, disannul and
 make Void all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made, In Witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & Seal this Eighth day of Jan^r in the year of Our Lord 1727.

This Indenture Made the third day of June in the first Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Brittain France and Ireland King defender of the faith &c. Unno Dom. One thousand seven hundred twenty & eight **Between** Elizabeth Warren and William Warren of the County of Surry of the one Part and Robert Warren of the same County of the other Part **Witnesseth** that the said Eliz^a Warren & William Warren for and in consideration of if Sum of five Shillings of Lawfull money of England to them in hand paid by the said Robert Warren at and before the Ensigning and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof and themselves therewith fully contented and paid they doth hereby Acknowledge & for divers ^{their} good causes & considerations them thereunto moving **hath** Granted bargained sold and Demised leased and to farm letten and by these Presents doth grant bargain sell Demise lease and to farm lett unto the said Rob^t Warren his heirs Execut^{rs} Administrators and Assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land wherein the s^d Rob^t Warren now Lives in Southwark Parish in the County of Surry (Yore said) containing two hundred and ^{fifty} Acres land be the same more or less bounded as followeth **Beginning** at Lion Hills line against the head of the (abbens then along the said Hills line) to a corner tree being a corner tree between the said Land and Ogbourne's land then along Ogbourne's line to the branch that devides the s^d Land and Allen Warrens Land then down that branch to the Wild Swamp then down the Wild Swamp to the mouth of hoggen Swamp then up hoggen Swamp to a line of Markit trees that devides the s^d Land and Elizabeth Thomas's Land then along the said line to a hickory being a corner tree in the Swamp then up the Swamp to the first Stacon with all Mesuages Tenements houses Cul houses Gardens Orchards fields Woods Underwoods Meadows ~~xxxx~~ Pastures feedings Swamps Marshes ways Waters Water Courses together with the Loyalties of hunting hawking fishing & fowling and Mines Mineralls & Quarries & all other Priviledges Advantages Profits Commodities & Appurtenances whatsoever to the s^d demised Premises belonging or in any wise Appurtenant together also with all Yearly Rents and Profits reserved in any Lease or Demise of any Part of the Premises **To have and to hold** the s^d Demised Premises and every Part thereof with the Appurtenances unto the s^d Rob^t Warren his heirs Execut^{rs} Admin^{rs} & Assigns from the day of the date hereof for and during the full term and time of three Years to be fully completed and ended **Yielding and paying** therefor yearly on the tenth day of December to the said Eliz^a Warren & William Warren their heirs Execut^{rs} Administrators or Assigns One Grain of Indian corn if it be demanded to the Intent & Purpose that by Virtue of these Presents and of Statute for transferring uses into Possessions the s^d Robert Warren may be in full & Peaceable Possession of the Premises before granted and may be thereby the better Enabled to Accept of a Grant or conveyance of the Reversion & Inheritance thereof to him and his heirs for ever **In Witness** Whereof the s^d Eliz^a Warren & William Warren hereunto Set their hands and Seals the day and Year first above Written
