In the Name of God Almighty Amen I Nick^l Smith of Southwark parish being
in perfect health sense and memory thanks be to Almighty God for it but considering the frailty and uncertainty
of mans life do make appoint and ordain this to be my Last Will and Testament in manner and form as followeth
First and above all I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it me trusting in the merits
of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ for a full and free pardon of all my Sins committed in this frail life and
my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named and for what worldly Estate
God hath been pleased of his mercy to bestow upon me after all my Just Debts paid I give and bequeath as followeth
I give unto my Son Nick^l Smith five Shillings and what he owes to me
2. I give unto my Son, John Smith fifty Acres of Land as it is marked out by me upon the head of the Ciffe River
where he hath built being more or less to him and his heirs for ever
3. I give unto my Son Lawrence Smith my horse bridle and Saddle
4. I give unto my Son William Smith my plantation and Land belonging to it whereon I now live with all
the houses and Orchard, as it now lies to him and his heirs male Lawfully begotten of his body and if it shall
please God that he die and Leave no heir male of his body then my Will is that my Grandson Nathaniel Smith
the Son of my Son John Smith shall possess my plantation and his heirs for ever
5. I give unto my Daughter Mary my feather bed and bolster and my bed Cloaths belonging to it
I do Appoint my Son William Smith my Executor of this my Last Will and Testament Respecting all
others made by me As Witness my hand and Seal this 18th day of February 1718/19
