Pursuant to an order of Surry County Court, to me directed, I have audited, stated and settled the foregoing account of the guardianship of William Crocker on the estate of James Wilson Orphan of Willis Wilson deceased from the Account book of William Crocker, the report of Samuel Wilson with exceptions filed thereto; and other exhibits produced by James Wilson: And find a balance of Eight hundred forty nine dollars and twenty six Cents, with interest on three hundred ninety nine dollars and ninety seven Cents (part thereof) to be computed from this day until the time of payment, due to the said James Wilson.

Henry Crocker administrator of William Crocker dec^d who was the guardian of James Wilson being regularly summoned to appear before your Commissioners and to produce and exhibit all the Books and papers of his Intestate touching the guardianship aforesaid, produced an account Book wherein is contained an account against the said James Wilson for the articles charged in this account, and credits for the Bonds here credited, as also a credit of sixteen dollars and sixty six cents for the rents of his lands the year one thousand eight hundred: without any vouchers to prove the charges or any regular account of the hires of the said James Wilson Slaves or of the Rents of his lands. William Crocker the guardian having credited the sum of \$16.66 for the Rents of his wards lands the year 1800, your Commissioner has credited this account for the like sum as the rents of his lands for the year one thousand eight hundred and one.

By an account current of the estate of Willis Wilson deceased, the father of the said James Wilson, administered by William Crocker and William Wilson, his administrators, there appears to be a balance due the estate of the said Willis Wilson of Four hundred thirty five pounds four shillings and ten pence half penny: of which balance the said James Wilson claims one fifth part, as one of the five distributees of Willis Wilson deceased: which your Commissioner has also admitted as a credit to this account, it being in the hands of the guardian as one of the administrators of the said Willis.

There being no date to the administration account aforesaid and it appearing to your Commissioner from the records of the Court that the administrators of Willis Wilson qualified and commenced their administration in the month of January one thousand eight hundred, he presumes that the monies arising from the sales of the personal estate, fell due previous to the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and one, and has allowed, and credited in this account interest on two hundred and ninety dollar and sixteen Cents (being his distributive share of the balance) from that day.

Your Commissioner has allowed to the guardian Commission at the rate of six per Centum on the money which came to his hands for the hire of the hire of the slaves and the rents of the lands; and has not allowed any on the monies which now, or ought to have been, in his hands from the estate of Willis Wilson decd because he had heretofore been allowed Commissions on that sum, in his administration account of that estate.

All of which is respectfully submitted to the Court.
