twelve hundred and forty pounds weight
of good sweete fowle and merchantable tobacco with
cash containing the same, to mee or my assignee by
Richard Ostracum Esquire or his assignee before ye delivery
hereof truly paid, the receipt whereof I doe hereby
acknowledge, I have given granted bargained assigned and
sell over, and by these presents doe fully & absolutely
give granted bargained sell assigne and sell over unto
said Richard Ostracum, one bay horse having
a black and white bridle down his face, and his two
hinder feet partly white, and the stone (culla) now
sitting on his, three bayne even, one red eye, one
bayne steere, one pyer banded steere, one black roe
one bayne roe with a mealy mouth, one pyer roe
with a blacke tail one bayne roe called raffe, and one
young foale called young white horse, And also all
my right claim and demands in and to my servants
and their families (Wit) William Savage for seven
years

James, William Douglas for his barons, and William
Horeman for his goods, all to come and enjoy, peace,
To have and to hold all and singular the before
granted and bargained promises, and only of them
unto the said Richard Dordale his executors, admors
and assigns as his and their own proper goods
and chattels to his and their own proper use and
benefit, for ever with warranty by me the said
James Dordale, my executors and administrators
against all persons whatsoever at all times hereafter
provided, likewise that if I the said James Dordale,
my executors, admors or assigns do sell and land
part and parcel, or cause to be part and parcel
unto the said Richard Dordale his executors or
assigns in some convenient place in or upon my
now plantation called or known by the name of
Dordale Mount aforesaid with in one quarter of
a mile distance of James river where a ship, barge
or galley may safely come and ride, the aforesaid
part of Dordale Mount three hundred and thirty
pounds weight of good sweet sound & merchantable
tobacco in leaf, with good sufficient and sound
rask to containe the same in manner followinge
(Viz) three hundred and thirty pounds weight
weight of good sweet sound & merchantable
tobacco in leaf, with good and sufficient
rask to containe the same, upon the tenth day
of October next ensuinge the date hereof
the said three hundred and thirty pounds weight
rask to containe the same more the said
tenth day of October with shalbe in the year of
our Lord 1655 and the other two hundred
pounds weight of good sweet sound & merchantable
tobacco in leaf, with good sufficient rask to
containe the same upon the tenth day of October
with shalbe in the year of our Lord 1656
that then the bargains and sale aforesaid
of the promises shalbe void and of none effect
if default shall happen to be made in
all, or any of the said paym^t in parts or
in all Contrarie to the forme aforesaid. Item

and at the place aforesaid the said sume Twelve
hundred and fiftie pounds, of lawfull
monie with good and sufficient ass^t to containe
the same, in manner and forme aforesaid without
makinge default thereon, in y^e or in all In witness
whereof I the said James Mason have hereunto

in the year of our lord 1634
