 worldly Estate it hath please God to possess me with all att^y my debts and
 Lawfull Charge is restrained I give bequeath & dispose of as followeth =

4th I give & bequeath to Coll^l Henry Duke Capt Tho: Holt Major Arthur
 Allen my mother's mason Sister Holt & Mary White to each of them ten
 Shillings to buy a Ring

4th I give and to my now marry the Daughter of Captain Tho: Holt
 five pounds Sterling.

4th I give and bequeath to L^{ts} Thomas Lane my Sword & Belt =

If my wife should at this present be the Child of a Boy I give and bequeath
 to him & his heirs for ever my plantation or tract of Land whereon now Live
 but it otherwise or y^e Boy should dye before he attain to Lawfull Age
 then I give and bequeath my s^d plantation or tract of Land to my son
 Francis Mason & to his heirs for ever & I likewise give my s^d son
 Francis to him & his heirs for ever y^e plantation or tract of Land whereon
 my mother's mason now Live and all y^e Rest & Remains of my Estate =

I give and bequeath to my Loving wife Elizabeth my son Francis
 and Cit my wife be the Child the Child she now goes to be Equally divided between
 y^e but it in Case my wife should not be the Child or happen to miscarry thereof it is then
 my Will and desire my s^d Estate be Equally divided between my s^d Love & my s^d son
 in this only difference y^e w^{ch} ever I deem & owing from me to y^e Estate
 of my Brother But do be paid and taken out of my wife's part I likewise
 hereby make ordain & constitute my Loving wife Elizabeth my sole Ex^{rs} of
 this my Last will & Testament in witness of which I have hereunto putt my hands and Seal
