

In the Name of God Amen the 19th day of Dec^r 1699 and in the Eleventh
year of the Reigne of o^r most gracious Sovereign Lord King William the third
of England Scotland France and Ireland Defender of the faith p^r J. John Allen
of Southwark parish in Surrey County being very sick and weak in body but of
sound and perfect memory (thanks be to Almighty God for the same) And being
to mind the uncertainty of this transitory life, and that all flesh must yield
unto death when it shall please God to call and being desirous to settle things in
order doe make this my last will and testament in manner and forme following
revoaking and absolutely annulling by these p^rsents all and every testament and
testamentary will and wills by me heretofore made and declared either by word
or by writing notwithstanding any promise to the contrary First I bequeath
my soul to Almighty God my maker and to Jesus Christ my Redeemer
and my body to the earth from whence it came to be buried in such decent
and Christian manner as to my Executor shall bee thought meete there to
rest untill my soul and body shall meet againe and bee joyned together
at the joyfull resurrection and bee made partakers of the never fading
joyes of immortality wh^{ch} God in mercy through the merits of Jesus
Christ alone hath promised and prepared for all those that truly & unfeignedly
repent and believe in him

And touching such temporall estate of goods chattells and debts as the
Lord hath been pleased farre above my desires to bestow upon mee I doe
order give bequeath and dispose thereof in manner and forme following

First I give and bequeath unto my eldest son John when hee shall
attaine the age of twenty one yeares out of Shilling Sterling money of England
to bee paid to him by my Executor hereafter named and no more of what
nature or quality soever of my estate

Then I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah one feather bed that shee
now lieth on with besides one paire of Shettles a blanket & rugg over and
above the equal part of the residue of my estate to bee delivered to her immediately
after my death and all the motheres clothes lately deceased

And for the residue of my estate whether here or elsewhere to bee equally divided
amongst my three youngest Children to each one third part to bee paid by
my Executor to the boyes when they shall come to the age of eighteen yeares
and to the girls when they shall come to fifteen yeares or day of marriage
or if shall first happen and to their heirs for ever.

Also I make constitute and appoint Nathaniel Harrison my sole Executor
of this my last will and testament empowering him to make payments of all my just
debts and legacies as witness my hand and seale the day & year above written

the sum of seven hundred and fourteen pounds of tob and hath
assigned himself out of the said County so that due process at
law cannot be had ag^t him

Wherefore in his Maties name to will and require y^e to attach so much
of the effects of the said Thomas Williams (if it can be found within y^e Dayward)
as may be sufficient to satisfy the said debt wth the contingent charges and so
provid^d that y^e have it forth coming at the next Court held for this County
therof, faith not ag^t y^e with cause the contrary And for y^e soe doing this shall be
sufficient warrant I will under my hand this 14th of Oct. 1700
