4: I Give my Son Henry One feather bed and pillow one Sheet & one red Blankett.

5: I Give my Daughter Hannah One Kieper big as the self called Spott if she should
Die then it is my Will that she should have another Kieper of the same Age and
and One Box Iron for her full part of my Estate and not to have any more share
with my Wife and Children.

And all the rest of my Estate after my Lawfull and Just Debts all paid to be equally
Divided Among my Wife and Children Except my Daughter Hannah Every
One to have an Equall part And I do Appoint Mr. Samuel Thompsett and

Mr. William Thomas to be Overseers of this my Last Will & Testament. In Wit-
ness hereof I have set my hand and Seale this 26th day of January 1709.
