Parish Being in perfect Health Sense and memory but considering the several
ways that mans life may be abridged I doe therefore renounce all former wills of what
sable power and doe appoint and ordain this my Last will and Testament as followeth
Imp^{ro} I bequeath my soule to God hoping by the merits of Jesus Christ to have Eternall
Salvation Item I bequeath my Body to the earth to be decently buried according
to the direction of my Executors as shall be hereafter named and as for
what worldly goods or Estate god have in mercy be stowed upon me I think
fit to bestow as followeth I Give to my dear and loving wife Anne Pulestone
all my whole Estate viz - fellell hegs - horses and mares Draff pewter and Beeing
all yt I poss^{ess} and Injoy both Ex^{pr}irit and Im^{pr}irit after my debts and funerall
charges be satisfied and paid my desires yt my dear and loving wife
Anne puleston may enjoy all the rest of my Estate I also give to my
dear and loving wife Anne pulestone all my whole power assigned to me by
m^r Alice Stranfer widow of London and Administrator of m^r Anthony
Stranfer of London merchant by a letter of Attorney bearing date the 12 day
of September 1669 desiring she may ael and doe in all things their to

appertaining as I have done during my naturall life appointing my dear
and Loving wife Anne pulstone my whole and Sole Executrix of this my last
will and Testament as witness my hand with Seal this fiftenday of may 1704

being Weak of body but of Perfect mind and memory calling to mind The uncertainty of
this life and that it is appointed for all men over to dye therefore make and ordaine
this my Last will and Testament in manner and forme as followeth -
I Give and bequeath my Soule to God That Give it to me Trusting in The merces and merits
of my Saviour Jesus Christ for full pardon forgiveness of all my sins and my body to be
Decently Buried -
I All The Disposition of my Executrix hereafter nominated and as for What worldly goods it
hath pleased God to bestow on me I Give and bequeath as followeth -
I my Will and Desier is that all my Just Debts I owe to any man be well and Truly Paid -
I my Will and Desier is that my Loving wife Alice have and In Joye The house and Land that
I now Live on With all the Profits and Commodities thereunto belonging During her tedious
hood and after her Death or marriage to Returne to my Son William Mariott to him I Give
my Land and housing after the Death or marriage of my Said Wife to him my Son
William Mariott and his Heirs for ever but if it should happen That my Son
William Mariott should dye before he Have any Issue of his Body Lawfully begotten
that then I Give and Bequeath my Said Land Housing and all Thereunto belonging
to my Gran Son Thomas Stake Son of Robert Stake to him and his Heirs Heirs
for ever -
I Give and bequeath all The Rest of my Estate to my Loving Wife Alice Mariott
and my Son William Mariott to Live in Common between them During my Said Wifes widow
hood and after shee should happen to marry againe Then That she have her Third
