This Indenture made in the thirtieth year of the Reigne of our Sovereign
 Lord King William the third of England Scotland France and Ireland Defender
 of the faith, Witnesseth that I Jeremiah Drayn son of Dan^e Drayn
 of the County of Surry in Virg^a for a valuable consideration of one thousand
 pounds of good sound tobacco to me in hand paid by W^m Gray of the same
 County aforesaid with w^{ch} I acknowledge my self fully contented satisfied and
 paid have bargained sold and delivered and do hereby for my self my heirs
 Executors and assigns for ever bargain sell and deliver in fee simple and confirmed unto the
 said W^m Gray his heirs Executors and assigns for ever fifty acres of land
 left me by my father in his will bee the same more or less lying and
 being in Surry County beginning at Red oak a Corner bett thence to a great
 poplar by John Lowrey's Spring thence West up the branch bounding upon
 John Lowrey's until it meete with his brother Dan^e Drayn's land thence
 southerly along Dan^e Drayn's land thence Easterly bounding on Joseph Sut
 till it meete John Drayn's land and continuing his line N. to his first
 station So have and to hold the same more or less with all woods water
 houses orchards waters profitsse improvements hereditaments thertunto belonging
 or in any way appertaining to him the said W^m Gray his heirs Executors &c
 for ever in a full and ample manner as the most learned in the law can devise
 And I doe hereby warrant and defend this my sale in all and singular the
 premises wth their appurtenances to him the said W^m Gray his heirs Executors &c for
 ever against any person or persons whatsoever as shall or may claime by
 force or matter or my heirs Executors &c or any other person or persons whatsoever
 and to acknowledge this to bee my real Act and deed in the next Court in County
 of Surry In witness of the same I have putt my hand and seal this 5th
 of Sept. 1699
