 And I doe appoint my dear and loving wife Priscilla Jordan my heire and sole
 executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other wills In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seale this 2^d day of Dec^r 1699

 parish of Southwark being sick and weak of body but of sound & perfect mind
 and memory all thank and praise be given to God for the same doe make and ordain
 this my last will and testament in manner and form following First and above all
 earthly things I commend my soul to God Almighty as surely believing through
 the merits of Jesus Christ I shall receive forgiveness of all my sinnes and my
 body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
 named, And as for the worldly estate that God hath been pleased to bless me wth
 I dispose thereof as followeth my just debts being first paid.

I give and bequeath to my son Robert Gully one black Cow called Black mty -
 & the calf out-stead of a year and a half and one heifer named Browning of the
 same age:

Item I got and bequeath to my son Robert one bed with the covering & one pair of sheets & a coverlet wth a bed to it & two pillows two small tables & a chair two stools and two forms & one gun and all other my household stuff except my furniture and furniture

Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Sully one cow named Whiteface & the calf

Item I give unto my daughter Lucy Sully one cow named Starred & one heifer with calf named Fancy

Item I give my feather bed bolster two pillows one rugge two blankets & one pair of sheets and four pillowcases with the bedstead equally between my two daughters Elizabeth and Lucy with all my wearing clothes linen & woollen to be equally divided between them

Item I give my daughter Elizabeth one chest wth lock key and I doe nominate and appoint my loving friends William Foreman and William Browne joint my sole Executors of this my will In Witness Whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and Seal this 18th day of Oct^r 1700
