4 I give and bequeth unto my Daughter Mary if Wife of William Phillips & to her heirs for ever my house Orchard & plantation whereon I now live which is bounded North W. by my Spring branch and y^e path that goes to In^o Rodwells and

5 I give and bequeth to my Daughter Sarah and her heirs for ever all the Remand of my land lying on y^e North Side of y^e aforesd branch & path wth this Reservation

alld out of my before mentioned Land or plantation given to my daughter Mary that my sd Daughter Sarah shall have hold possess and Enjoy y^e aforesd plantation wth y^e appurtenances for and during y^e term of eighty year Equally in all

Respects to my aforesd Daughter Mary & my sd Daughter Sarah taking care from time to time as occasion shall require to keep in repair or pay & Satisfie for keeping in Repair y^e out halts of all y^e house Orchards & Foundation y^e sd plantation now standing

Indiately after her decease I give my said Negro woman to my Grandson In^o Phillips to whom I also give and bequeth My Bed and furniture as it now stands in my outward Room

7 I give and bequeth to my aforesd Daughter Mary my warming pan

8 I give and bequeth to my Daughter Sarah the two Beds whereon I now live with all y^e furniture thereto belonging as it now stands in my m^r Room

and I also give to my said Daughter Sarah a small trunk & Chest wth lock and key in my m^r Room aforesd together with six New pewter dishes plates

six New pewter porringers six pewter spoons a quart pewter tankard and a pewter Chamber pot a brass Candlestick two New Iron pots and my own Riding horse wth her m^r & side saddle and furniture

9 I give and bequeth all y^e Rest and Remand of my Estate after my debts and Legacies paid to be Equally divided betwixt my two Daughters Elizabeth Mary and Sarah and I do hereby Nominate appoint and ordain

My Son in Law ² Geo Broo and my Daughter Sarah ² of this my Last Will and Testament in testimony of all which I have herunto putt my Seal this 14th of December Anno Domini 1702
