remission of all my sins my body I commit to the Earth from whence it came to be
buried in Christian burial and for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow
upon I give and bequeath in manner following -

Imp 1. I give unto Henry Holingsworth at my door a Cow Calve -

It - I give unto Gordon Rich^d & Phelps a two year old horse & a vast tract of
of brooder and a Coach Cote -

It - I give unto my Son Rich^d Bullock when he comes to be of y^e age of
Eighteen years of plantation whereon I now live with all y^e Land belonging to it
to him and his heirs for ever I shall give him some pounds in Cash to show
how by me y^e which I do desire y^e Hon^{ble} Benjamin Harrison Esq^r to keep in his
hands until my Son Rich^d comes to be of y^e age of Eighteen I give more unto
my Son Richard a bath & bed and furniture belonging with Brown porter -
After two porter basins two copper basins two silver spoons four porringers
one brass kettle quart & twenty gallons a brass Skimmer and Ladle one
gum and Bible I also give my Son Rich^d six Cows -

It - I give unto my Love & wife Mary Bullock all y^e rest of my Estate to possess
both real and personal and to be by her disposed of as she shall think convenient
to the death and I desire y^e how owing me and do desire my Loving wife to buy my
Son Rich^d a young Mare to be given to him when of age this is my last Will
and to which I do unto to my hand and seal this 2nd day of March in the
Year of o^r Lord 1703
