2^{ly} I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Lucy my Land during y^e time of her Widowhood & after that shee doth come to Marry my Land to return to my heire

3^{ly} Robt Gully I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Lucy all the rest of my Estate Real & personall after my just debts & funerals Expenses is satisfied

4th I doe make & ordaine my loving Lucy my heire and sole Ex^{te}

5^{ly} I desire my two loving friends W^m Hordern and Edward Bookery to assist and advise my wife & to see this my Will performed In Witnes whereof we have hereunto set my hand and Seale this 15th day of August 1695
