of my old plantat: So by a Line of Market trees downward to a Branch to a
marked live Oak by y^e plantat: I now live att So up y^e said Branch to a
market pine standing at y^e head Line of y^e said Land so round y^e said Land
to y^e first Beginning & a year old heifer marked wth a rope and two flits in each
ear & an Overheel in y^e 1st year to him and his Heires for ever.

a Crown to her and her Heires for ever. Item I Give to my Son John
Killingworth y^e remaining part of my Land being y^e plantat: I now live att

true & Loving Wife Ann Killingworth my whole & Sole Execut: of this my Last
Will and Testament and do give her privilege of Seating or binding any part of my
fores: Land during her widowhood but if she doth marry then only y^e plantat:
I now live att & y^e during her life. This being y^e sume of my Last Will and
Testament w^{ch} may not be Violated - As Witness my hand and Seal this twenty
ninth of Nov^r In y^e year of Lord 1709
