and Land bounded thus with an Addition of an neck of Land lying between
my two plantations. Divided by a Line of markt trees the out ware park beginning
att a markt whitewood In y^e mouth of a Branch being y^e Lower bound
of my old plantation. So by a Line of Markt trees downward to a branch to a
marked live Oak by y^e plantation. I now live att so upp y^e said branch to a
markt pine standing at y^e head Line of y^e said Land so round y^e said
tree y^e first Beginning & a year old heifer marked w^t a Crop and two Stots in each
ear & an Overkeel in y^e third year to him and his Heires for ever.

Item I Give to my Daughter Lucy Gullidge One young sow to y^e value of half
a Crown to her and her Heires for ever. Item I Give to my Son John
Killingworth remaining part of my Land being y^e Plantation. I now Lendatt
to him and his Heires for ever. After I Appoint Constitute and Ordaine my
true & Loving Wife Ann Killingworth my whole & Sole Execut^r of this my
Will and Testament and do give her griviledges of Seating or tending any part of my
afores^d Land during her widewhood but if she doth marry then only y^e plantation
I now live att & y^e during her Life. This being y^e sume of my Last Will and
Testament as may not be Violated. As witness my Hand and Seal this twenty
ninth of Nov^r In y^e year of Lord 1709.
