I now give and bequeath unto Hannah Richerill my well beloved wife all my hole Estate in General is her & her assigns and doe Consiluto & ordain Hannah my well beloved wife my hole and soul &c &c is too this my last will & testam^t truly performed in witness whereunto I have set my hand and seal this day and year above written
