summe of one hundred and fifty pounds sterl to the true performance and payment
whereof to the said Newell as at his now dwelling house in the parish and County
afforead or toward I hereby oblige my self my heirs Executors and Administrators —
Witness my hand and seal this 20th Nov.

The Condition of the above oblong w^{ch} saith that Whereas he about bounden James Briggs —
paid this day 100⁰ and remaynes to the above named Newell and to his heirs and Assignes for ever —
a certaine plantation deuided or tract of land situate and being in the parish and County aforesaid
containing one hundred acres more or lesse as by the said conveyance (relation being hereto had) —
now at large may appear, Now if the said James Briggs his Heires Executors and Administrators shall —
from time to time and at once after the said William Newell his Heires and Assignes in the —
prestable and quitt possession of the abovesaid tract or deuided of land and Rightes the aforesaid —
heires belonging according to the intent and meaning of the conveyance aforesaid Then the —
above oblong to the rest and of none effect Otherwise to stand and remayne in full force power &
virtue.

the County of Surrey in Eng^a Being sick and weak and daily capitaining my change —
from this mortall life to the life immortall for that it is appointed for all men once
to dye but some of sound and perfect minde and memory praised be God who made me —
and directed this my last will and testament in manner and forme following that is to —
say first I committed my soul to God my maker hoping assuredly through the intercession
of Jesus Christ my Saviour to make partaker of the life everlasting, And I commited —
my body to the earth from whence it came to be decently buried at the discretion —
of my Executors hereafter named;

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Robert Pittaway and the heirs of his body —

Lawfully begotten the plantation on wherupon I now dwel beginning at the
saiding of Crotches Creek keeping the breadth from Creek to Creek till it
comes to Judson's Spring thence by a line of marsh led to a tree tree -
of my land that my father formerly gave me the said Creek side stands in of land of a
valley formerly called the Thunderbolt valley along the valley to the main swamp
and if it shall so happen that my son Robert or his heirs shall any way
molest his brother Edward or his heirs from enjoying of a part of land that
my father gave to me and to the heirs of my body then my will is that Edward
my son shall have and enjoy this tract I now have upon and the heirs of
his body lawfully begotten.

Item I give unto my son Edward Pittway all the rest of my land belonging to this -
dearly of the land my father formerly gave me to give to him & to the heirs
of his body lawfully begotten, And if it shall happen that either of them shall
be my son Robert or Edward shall have to sue without cause then
my will is that the other shall enjoy both lands.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son William Pittway and to the heirs of his
body lawfully begotten a part of land containing four hundred acres
lying and being on the east side of Western Branch of Crotches Creek bounding
upon the land of John Lemon, & if it shall so happen that my wife
be with child with a man child that the said child shall enjoy half the
said four hundred acres of land I give my son William

Item I give and bequeath unto my living wife my gray gobling one feather bed on
which she lies with all its furniture, and one great chest one round table
one bushel one pair of fire tongs two spinning wheels, one frying pan one
iron pot three plates dishes one basin one tankard one tomble.

Item I give unto my son Robert my best Traffilled with all its furniture one great
chest one iron chest containing ten gallons, one spirit measure pottle, p one
poker about six yards old and two young toward p calico two young Savoy c.
ring, and one Cupboard, and one long table, six plates dishes, one basin one tankard
one fire bowl, one greater candle stick, one warming pan one iron pot, one great
bible:

And all the rest of my worldly goods after all my lawful debts payed off my chaste
my will is that it shall be equally divided between my wife and my two youngest
sons Edward and William

And further I do ordain and appoint my living wife to be my first and sole
executor of this my last will and testament, And I do desire my will be read
before Mr. John Thompson, Thomas' Lant to take the oversight of this my last
will and testament, And in case my Executor should die I desire that Mr.
John Thompson shall have the management of my son Robert until he shall
arrive at the age of twenty one years old And Thomas' Lant to have the manage-
ment of my son Edward till he shall arrive at the age of twenty one years old After
my death and shall have 15th day of Dec: 1696
