interrupted I have thought fitt by and with the advice of his Majesty's Council
of this Colony in his Majesty's name to publish and declare that all Magistrates &
Officers both civil and Military doe continue and remain in all and singular their
powers authorities and jurisdictions until further order be taken therein, hereby
requiring them to proceed in the execution of their severall duties, and all his
Majesty's Subjects within this Colony are to bee aiding and assisting to them therein
and to give all due obedience to this proclamation I Wrote with my hand and the
Seale of the Colony the 9th day of Dec^r in the tenth year of the reign of our
Sovereign Lord William the third by the grace of God of England Scotland France
and Ireland King Defender of the faith Annoq^{ue} Domⁱⁿⁱ 1698
