my whole haul of Land shall be divided to each a like both for propor-
tion & goodniss, but that my wife shall enjoy an equal priviledge wth
my Son Francis during her life, I leaving him that p^{te} wth he
the houseing Orchard now is.
Moreover I give unto my Daughter Sarah three Cow's wth Calfes or Calves by them: &c.
To my daughter Eli I give two Cow's & Calfes or Calves by them: &c. in like
manner to every one of my Sonns living when they come to the age of
Twenty one
To my Brother Thomas I give a Gold Ring or Silver spoon of ten shillings price
To my Bro: James I give a hog's head wth Calfes by her side &c.
Increase during his life that at his decease what remains shall
from them or thore Increase shall come amongst my Children
Every one on an equal share.
To my Daughter Jane Rix I give a Gold Ring of twenty shillings price
To my daughter Sarah I give (to be) beside the three Cow's aboves
specified of me a foale the first that is weaned
To my loving wife I give all my Estate of what kind: or Nature
soever excepting what is above disposed of paying my debts & giving
me Defent buriall And thus I make my last Will & Testament as
witness my hand this 8 day of November: 1678
