desire for clemency for the same, I give & committ my soul to -
the mercies of my Saviour & redeemer by whose Merit only
I trust to be saved & my body to be buried in such place as
it shall please my said Lord hereafter named to appoint, & for what
temporal goods & it hath pleased God to bestow upon
me, I give bequeath & deliver in manner & forme following
that is to say after my debts are duly contented & paid by my
Executor hereafter named.

I give to my son Harry Goring all that my Land at Black
water in Lury County in Lawnes & other parts, which I purchased
of Philip Hunsford to him & his heirs forever, but in case of his
death before lawfull age, I give it to my son William Goring, & in
case of his death before lawfull age to my son Nathaniell Goring
Item I give to my said Son Harry my Gun

Item I give to my Son William my young horse, now sick
Item I give to my Son Nathaniell and yearding her for my rest
of my Estate after my debts are paid to be Equally divided among
my aboves three Sons, and of the my last will & testament make
Constitute ordaine my Lording friend John Goring my full & whole
Executor of my desire, my said Son to take into his possession & tuition
my aboves Son Harry until he comes to lawfull age, In witness
