my desire I do hereby Will & bequeath all the Landesome
of Right belonging or in any wise appertaining to him
Holt the Son of m^r Randall Holt late of this County.

and his Heirey for ever and the remaining pte of
my said Estate to be Equally divided betwene the said W^m
Holt and his Brother Thomas Holt during his life forever
It is my desire I do hereby Reguist my Sonny Kurnan &
Charles Morrison to take into his care & tuition my said son
Charles & to instruct him in up & educato him as he
shall think fit, where together with my Looing friend
Robert Caufield I appoynt my full & sole Executo to see
this my last Will performed, revoking & depecting
all other Wills by me made, appoynting & confirming
this to be my last Will and Testam^t, In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 5th of May 1679
