paid out of my Estate & if remaining part thereof I give &
bequeath to my loving wife margott & my two Children
James & mary Hoog to be justly & Equally divided
betwixt them my s^d Wife & Children Excepting one
yearling Hoifer which I do give and bequeath unto my
Wifes Daughter Eliz: Cooper my will & desire further is that
if Either of my s^d Children before named should dye
before they come to my s^d son of Age of Eighteen years &
my Daughter to of Age of fifteen years at which Ages I
desire they may be poss^d with their Estates, that the

Survivor shall enjoy of & receive parts & share
I do hereby nominate & appoint my s^d Le. Wife Executrix
of this my last will & testament & Also my s^d Friends and
Robert Ruffin & me William Nowam Overseers to see this
my will truly executed & performed to all which I have
set my hand & seals this seventeenth day of may 1679
