 I give after all my Just debts are paid, I give to Geo:
 Williams two hundred pounds of Tob: to buy him a Ring
 It I give my Son In: Smith my small Gun & all my
 Cattle & hogs with all the goods of the house & the
 plantation to him & his heirs forever, And if it
 please God my Son above said dye before hee come of
 age, then my Will is that Geo: Williams shall enjoy
 the whole Estate for him & his heirs forever
 It my will is that Geo: Williams be my sole Executor
 to whom I bequeath my Son, requesting his Christian
 Love in the Carefull Education of my Son
 It I declare this to be my last Will & Testament to which
 I have subscribed this 23. of July 1679
