I give to John the of John priest and more running at Blackwater
which was formerly my sister Mary Whites

I give to John priest Senio the one halfe of what is due from him
to me

I give to William Mewson the one halfe of what is due from him
to me

I give Robert Cusbills fifty shilling ster: to buy him A Ring

I give my sister Lucy Fowler A Golds Ring now on my finger
I give & Bequeath my whole Estate of what nature or kind
soever it be, & in whoes hands or Custody soever it Remains After
my debts & charges are paid to my sisters Mary White & Lucy Fowler
to be Equally divided Betwene them, & do hereby Appoynt my sai
making Voyce & null all wills by me formerly made & don & do by the
present Appoynt & ordain this to be my last will & Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & scale this first day of Apr
1679
