I bequeath to my sonn Rich: Drow which proells of land I confirmed to my
sonns Edward John & Rich: to them & their heirs of thore body lawfully
begotten as for y^e rest of my estate to my loving wife wth y^e plantation
land & houseing during her naturall life to my daughter mabell Drow
all her dossetts, suters waring clothes If it please god that any of thore
my sonns shall dye then my will is that y^e survivors shall Enoy the
others part further God appoint my loving friends and Rob: Causfield
and my sonn Thomas Drow overseers to see this my will p^{er}formed In
Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & seale this 4th of
April 1679
