begotten as for the rest of my estate to my louing wife w^t y^r plantation
Land & houseing during her naturall life to my daughter mabell Drew
all her esecutors sisters wastring clothes if it please god that any of these
my sons shall die then my will is that y^e survivors shall enjoy the
other part futher god almighty my louing friends and Rob: Confield
and my son Thomas Drew beare bards to see this my will performed In
