

Know all men by these presents that I John Clarke of Surry
County planter doth give unto Henry King my son in law (as pointed
in the Isle of Wight County) to his wife Katharine King my
Daughter one hundred Acres of Land situated & lying in
Surry County: during both these Natural lives, not to be
either sold or changed, mortgaged or leased for above seven
years or farther: & after the Death of the said King &
his wife then the said hundred Acres of Land to be equally
divided between Wm King & Hen. King both my Grand-
children to them & their heirs forever lawfully-
begotten, and neither of the Children to sell (change
Mortgage or lett it for above seven years, & if either of
the Children Wm King or Henry King shall die without
Issue then the whole hundred acres of Land to come to
the survivor the said Land is bounded as followeth, -
beginning one bound of Edward Browne & go down the Sample
to the mouth of a deepe branch road up the bank to & outside
of my bound, but I John Clarke to have timber of of any
part of the said hundred Acres of Land for the use of my
one plantation without lett or molestation. but the said
Henry King to have all privilege whattsoever making no
waist of any thing as witness my hand and Seal this first
of 9th 1684
