Virg: ss: By his Excellency
 A Proclamation

Whereas his most Sacred Maj^{ty} by his Royall Lett^{rs} & Patents
 under the broad Seal of England, bearing date at
 Westminster Septemb^r. 28. 1635. y^e of his Raignt, was
 graciously pleased to make Commission^{er} & Constitude in Praying
 Lord Howard Baron of Effingham, to be his Maj^{ty} Sec^y
 Govern^r Gen^l of this his Dominion of Virg^{ia}, in y^e Lett^{rs} & Patents
 to content a Commission of Instructions for the bett^r & more Secure Managing
 and ordering of all & ordinary affayres of this his Governm^t to direct by
 due Execution of & p^{ro}vid^e authority therein given, and amongst other
 things therein contained, his Maj^{ty} is pleased to declare his Will, please
 to be, that in case of my Death or absence from this his Maj^{ty}
 Governm^t and there be noe other p^{er}son appointed by his Maj^{ty} to be
 Comand^r in Chief, that then, present Councill of Virg^{ia} do take
 upon them the Administration of & Governm^t and Execute the afore-
 mentioned Commission of Instructions and all y^e p^{ro}vid^e authority therein
 contained, as also, & such Councillor who by his Maj^{ty} Instructions
 to me given, is first nominated, and residing in & Governm^t to Preside
 in & Councill, with such p^{ow}ers & preheminency, as any p^{re}sident
 hath ever enjoyed within this his Maj^{ty} Colony of Virg^{ia}: and whereas
 by & Especiall Grace favo^r: & good leave of his Maj^{ty} in Councill, Jam^s
 suddenly Intended for some short time to pass to New-yorke, & p^{re}sent
 Quietness of affayres, together with & good provision made for the
 defence of & frontiers, smitting my absence, and have thereby a hopefull
 prospect of settling a firme & lasting Peace with the Generall Indians,
 w^{ch} if accomplished will be greatly for his Maj^{ty} service, & this Country
 wellfare, & whereas there is noe person in this Governm^t either in case of
 my Death or absence, Commissioned by his Maj^{ty} to be Comand^r in Chief,
 therefore to & Intent it may be Generally knowne in whome this
