John Moring aged sixty one y^{rs} or thereabouts
sworn saith: that somewhat about four years since
this deponent together with some of the neighbours
being possessed of lands of Capt. Rob. Randall now in
the possession of m^r Tho. Swann, doth remember that
the lines dividing the lands of y^e Capt. Randall &
Tho. Swann were peaceably & quietly possessed
without any Lett Contradiction or objection made
by y^e said Swann, & grows up to a marked white oak that
stands on the right hand of the path going to
house of Jn^r Byrd & this deponent further saith
that he doth very well remember that y^e Swann &
Randall did both propose & seeme willing & desirous
to mark out a head line from y^e affore^said oak
but they could not agree which way the same should
run & for that reason only did forbear to mark
any head line & further saith not
sworn before me 7th 1690
