and dues, in & said County, during the time of his
Majesties and also due payment made, of all such publick
Dues, as shall be levied in the aforesaid County of Surry,
unto several persons shall be appointed to receive of
same, & full performed make, of all things belonging to
the Office of Sheriff of the aforesaid County, and to do here by
Command all their Ma^{ties} Officers, both Civil & Military, &
other and in Ma^{ties} Subjects Inhabiting & said County, &
others actually there to be aiding & assisting to & by
Mr. Francis Mason as High Sheriff, in all things
relating to the Office of Sheriff of the aforesaid County
