of all my sins And my body to the earth to be decently buried in Christian
buriall according to the discretion of my loving Uncle Tho^h fflood

Item I give & bequeath to my loving Uncle Richard Rose all my
wareing Cloths and what Tob^h he^{ll} me only my best hat to my brother
Thomas Avery

Item I give & bequeath all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided
between my brother Thomas Avery and John Avery only my brother tho^h
to have his choice of my guns
