mortall life I Begudeth my soule to him my Creator
Trusting in his alme mercies of Jesus Christe my bles-
sed Saviour & Redemer resting in suretyt
hope of regeneration & my body to the Earth from
whence it came to be decently interred for what
worldly estate it hath pleased God to blesse me withall
It is my will and desirer that it be digged as followeth
First I do give unto my Daughter Hannah one fea-
ther bed & bolster & a red rug & a pair of blankets & a
pair of sheets & a bedstead & two poulter dishes & a gro-
spott of four gallons & three cows & two two year
old heifers & a yearling calfe whereto comes of
olde & a yearling filly Secondly I do give unto
my daughter Mary one bed of feather & flockes
together & a bolster & a smooth red rug & a pair
of blankets & a brimble bedstead & three cows & one
two years old heifer & a yearling calfe & a brashkettle
of tenne gallons and two large poulter dishes & two large
Poulter plates Thirdly I do give unto my sonn Thomas
all my Land in generall after the decease of my
my Wife & a flock bed & bolster & a green rug
a pair of good canvas sheets & three cows & a large
heifer & two stedes of two years old apesse & large
old yars of two leather chairs after he comes of
age & further it is my will and desirer that after
sonn comes of age if mary my wife be not willing
to leave the plantation whereon I now live that
