After the payment of my just debts & my legacies above
expressed it is my will and desire that hereby given
bequeath all the rest of my Estate of what kind Property
or quality soever it be to my loving wife Jane & my
two Daughters Sarah and Susanna to be Equally di-
vided between them and I do hereby make and
ordains my loving wife aforesaid my full sole
Executrix of this my last will and Testament & bequeath
my all former wills heretofore by me made I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this 2nd of March 1691
