or a agreement in that behalfe, acquittance or acquittances or any  
other lawfull discharge, for me and in my name to make, and give  
and further to do, and performe all and whatsoever else Law  
can or may allow as fully and effectually as my selfe might or could  
doe were I personally present All which I shall and will ratifie and confirme
