being sick & weak of body but in perfect sound memory
do make this my last Will & Testament whosoever
it shall please the Almighty God to take me out of this
mortal life I bequeath my soul to him my friends
Trusting in the almighty merits of Jesus Christe my bles-
sed Saviour & Redeemer resting in sure & certain
hope of resurrection & my body to the Earth from
whence it came to be decently Interred for what
worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me
It is my will and desire that it be disposed as followeth
First I do give unto my Daughter Hannah one pair
of sheets & a bolster & a red rug & a pair of blankets &
a pair of sheets & a bolster & a pair of plates & a pair of
spoon of four gallons & three cows & two two years
old heifers & a yearling calf whosoever comes of
Age & a yearling filly Secondly I do give unto
my daughter Mary one bed of feathers & flock
together & a bolster & a smooth red rug & a pair
of blankets & a trunk bedstead & three cows & two
two years old heifers & a yearling calf & a bag of
fourteen gallons and two large pewter dishes & two large
pewter plates Thirdly I do give unto my son Thomas
all my Land in generall after the decease of my
Wife & a flock bed bolster & a good rug &
a pair of good canvas sheets & three cows & a yearling
heifer & two steers of two years old apiece & large
old gun & two leather chairs after his coming of
Age & further it is my will and desire that after my
son comes of age if my wife be not willing
to leave the plantation whosoever I now live that

Then he may give & sell a plantation on the
 other side of the Little Creek upon the other part
 of my dividend of land without molestation.
 And fourthly I do give unto Mary my wife
 all the rest of my whole Estate in general & only
 my clothing Coats I do give unto my brother in
 law Wm Knott and further if in case that my
 daughter Hannah should dye in her minority
 that then her part shall be Equally divided between
 my daughter Mary & my son Thomas and if
 both my s^d Daughters dye in their minority
 that then both their parts shall fall to my
 son Thomas & if my s^d son should dye in
 his minority that then all their parts of Estate
 shall go to Mary my Wife & the Lawfull heirs
 of her body for ever making and by these words
 Constituting & ordaining Mary my s^d Wife my
 whole sole Executrix to see this my last will &
 Testament performed & so God rest my soul
 In Heaven whosoever it shall please him to
 take me out of this mortall life given under
 my hand & seal this Eighth day of May 1688
