and Fra: Mason be overseers to see this my will fully
Executed & performed according to y^e Intent meaning
therof & that my overseers doe take care to see my
Estate be well secured for y^e use of my 6. Children and
that it be at thers power to Requite take security of
my 6. Executrix for y^e certain paymt. when they shall
be of Lawfull age to become it in Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & seal this 2. day of march
