

In the Name of God Amen. I Benjamin Harrison of Surry County Knowing of Uncertainty of mans Life
how unfit we are when pains & sickness comes upon us to settle our worldly affairs Do therefore with due con-
sideration make & Ordain this to be my last Will & Testament hereby revoking making void & annulling all other former Wills by me
made: First I bequeath my soul to Almighty God that gave it me: Next partly believing through y^e merits of my Saviour Je-
sus Christ I shall receive full & Absolute Pardon for all my sins my body I Commit to y^e Earth from whence it was
taken to be Decently buried at y^e Discretion of my Executor & for y^e worldly Estate that God of his mercy & Goodness he has
bestowed upon me I Dispose of that in manner following.

Imp^r I give unto my son Nathaniel One hundred Acres of Land wherein his Mill now stands half an acre of Land in y^e Town of New
bury hundred & all my Land in Martins Brandon in Prince George County all which parcels of Land I give to my said Son &
to his Heirs for ever.

Item: I give unto my son Henry y^e Plantation wherein I now live with y^e remaining part of y^e said Land I bought of John Barber
which is not already conveyed to him I also give him four hundred & fifty Acres of Land in one Plantation & one hundred & fifty Acres
of Land in one other Plantation & all my Land at Cabbins Point all beginning to my Plantation & Land which I over all parcels or
tracts of Land I give unto my said Son & to his Heirs for ever: I also give to my said Son all y^e negroes & other Slaves &
that shall belong to my Plantations at y^e time of my Death & all y^e Slaves that live at Cabbins Point I also give him all
my Cattel Horses mares Sheep & Hogs that belong to y^e two Plantations I also give him all my Plate & Household
Furnishings as Furniture Linen Woolen Pewter Brass Iron &c with all my bedding & all my Books I also give him my new
Clothes Henry with all my Boats & y^e Sails & what else I have sent for for y^e use of y^e said Henry if it please God it
shall come safe but my will is that in case my son Henry should Die without an Heir of his body lawfully begotten;
then my will is that all y^e Real Estate that I have given to my son Henry should goe to my son Nathaniel & to his Heirs
for ever he paying my Grandson Benjamin Harrison one hundred pounds Current money out of y^e said Estate.

Item: I give unto William Bringer my three hundred & fifty Acres of Land on y^e south side of Blackwater Swamp where my Quarters
now is to him & to y^e Lawfull Heirs male of his body for ever but for want of such Heir or in case he remove out of the
County then my will is that y^e said Land do goe unto my son Henry & to y^e Lawfull Heirs of his body for ever: & for
want of such Heir I give it to my son Nathaniel & to his Heirs for ever I also give unto y^e Bringer One male
Negro not under fifteen nor above thirty years of Age & two Cows & Calves.

Item: I give unto John Barber that part of my Land at y^e old Mill that lyes on y^e south side y^e crutch wherein he now
lives to him & to his Heirs for ever.

Item: I give twenty pounds sterling to my Executors for y^e Chappell & that my Executors take care to provide them as soon as ma-
ny a few y^e new Chappell is built & my will is that five Acres of my Land be laid out where y^e old Chappell now stands & that
it be held for that use for ever.

Item: I give unto my Daughter Sarah four hundred pounds Current money or sterling.

Item: I give unto my Daughter Hannah four hundred pounds Current money or sterling.

Item: I give unto my Grandson Benjamin Harrison four hundred pounds Current money or sterling to be paid to him when he comes to
age.

Item: I give to every one of my Grand Children one hundred pounds Current money or sterling a piece to be paid to each of them as they come
of Age or Marry which shall first happen my Grandson Benjamin Harrison only accepted he being already provided for.

Item: My will is that after my Just Debts & Legacies above mentioned with my just debts (namely to y^e fully satisfied) I give all y^e rest
of my Estate unto my son Nathaniel whom I do appoint my full & sole Executor: whether money in England or Barbados: Debts
here in y^e Country Goods in y^e Store or what else I have it be by what kind or quality I see that is not already given by this
my Will. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 20th Day of April 1722.
