In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Adkins of Southwark Parish In y^e County of Surry being very Sick and Weak of Body but of perfect Sense and Memory Do make and Ordaine this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me made I Trust I Bequeath my Soul to Almighty God which gave it Trusting Surely in the merits and mercies of my Blessed Saviour Christ Jesus my Body I Commit to y^e Earth from whence it came to be decently buried with Christian buriall and for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to Bless me withall I Give & Bequeath as followeth my Just Ditts first paid.

Item first I Give unto my Son Tho: Adkins my Plant and Land that I now Live on to him & his Heires forever and also Give to my Son Tho: One Gray Mare and all her increase and One Cow calf and all her increase and One Sow piggs and all her increase.

Item I Give unto my Son Richard Adkins one tract of Land lying upon y^e Land I Give my Son Tho: taken up wth Peter Bagley to him and his Heires forever and also I Give to my Son Richard Adkins One Cow to be Delivered him when he comes to y^e Age of Eighteen: It is my desire that all my Sons may be free at Eighteen years old. Moreover I do Give to my Son Tho: a pair of One Iron pot One Gun and One Sword. Item I do Give unto my Son William and to my Son In: Adkins each of them One Sow Shoat a piece. Item I do Give unto my Daughter Jane and my Daughter Anna Adkins Wives to Joseph Harris and Wife to Tho: Dunn Each of them One Sow Shoat a piece. Item I do Give to my Daughter Joan Adkins One Sow of six Years old with all her increase and also One Looking Glass. Item I do Give to my Daughter Mary and my Daughter Rachell Adkins Each of them One Cow Calf a piece. Item I do Give unto my beloved Wife Anna Adkins all the rest personal Estate whatsoever to be by her disposed of as she shall think fitt and I do further Constitute and Ordaine my beloved Wife Anna Adkins to be my whole and Sole Execut: to see this my Last Will and Testament fulfilled to which I have hereunto sett my hand and Seal this 26th day of May In y^e Year of Our Lord 1711
