In the name of God Amen, I Elizabeth Zell of Supra County being in perfect Health and Memory do make this my last Will and Testament as followeth, first I give my Soul to God, my Body to the Earth to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, Trusting in Merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ and in hope of a joyful Resurrection at the day of judgment.

First I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas Browning five shillings to be paid by my Executor hereafter named.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son John Zell five shillings to be paid by my Executor.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Clark five shillings to be paid by my Executor.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son David Zell all my Personal Estate and money to him and his heirs for ever, after my Debts and funeral expence be first paid & discharged.

And I do constitute and appoint my Son David Zell my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have set my Hand and Seal this fourteenth day of December, in the Year of our Lord God 1760.
