I give & bequeath to my son Nathl^r Parham one Tract or parcel of Land being in Brunswick County Containing by Estimation one hundred & fifty Acres in his allowing my beloved Wife the use of one half of the said Tract or parcel of Land During her Natural Life Sales give and Bequeath to my son Nathl^r Parham my Negroes Charles Joe Mingo, Sam Dickey Chale Ben Shann, Dick Winney Gloggy, I say I Bequeath the Negroes to him his Heirs & assigns for Ever.

Mem I give & Devise to my Daughter Jane Shewat the following Negroes - James Judith Mackell Lydia Dick Hannah Dancy also my will & desire is that my Daughter Jane Shewat have the free use & benefit of my Negroes boy Stephen During her natural Life & at her decease to be disposed of as she shall think most proper.

Mem I give and bequeath to my Daughter Frances Ge my Negroes Ned Sarah, Ben Cain Dick and Pegg I say I Devise the same to her, her Heirs & assigns forever.

Mem I give and Bequeath to my son W^m Parham my plantation whereon I now Live to situate with all my Lands & appurtenances adjoining it after the Decease of my beloved wife together with my Negroes James George Peter James Dancy Ned &c. also I give and bequeath to my son W^m Parham one Negroe woman called Anahie three young Negroes the Children of Anahie viz Lucy Frank & Pat. I say I Devise the same to him & his Heirs for Ever.

Mem I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca Parham my Negroes Donald Ben Amos Shewins my Negroe Wench called Hagar together with a Child of hers called Alf also a Negroe boy called Dick, I say I Devise the same to her & her Heirs for Ever.

Mem I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Rebecca Parham my Negroes Old Dick Robin Simon, Hannahs Little Sarah Old Sam Moore & Tom I say I Bequeath the same to her her Heirs & assigns for Ever also I give & bequeath to my beloved wife all the Remainder of my Estate except a parcel of Hogs known by the Name of the Spotted Gang which I Devise to my son W^m Parham I say Bequeath the same to her, her Heirs & assigns for Ever.

And I do hereby appoint my sons Nathl^r Parham & Henry Ge Executors of my beloved Wife Rebecca Parham last will & Testament Revoking all others before by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Twenty Eighth Day of March Anno Domini 1763
