In the Name of God Amen March the 16th 1763 I George North of the County of Sussex Being a Sane & Perfect man my last will & testament in writing for the same make and declare this to be my last will & testament in writing and term following, I give my wife to God that good & trusting in the Mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ for the Remission of all my Sins & my Body to be Buried in a Christian and decent manner according to the Direction of my Executors hereafter mentioned, and bequeathing such Holy Goods as it hath been my will to be given upon my decease to the same as follows.

Item I give and Devise unto my Grandson George North, son of George North, all that East Angles in Sussex County lying on the south side of Toppenny Creek & South west shore of New Can Lake, viz one hundred Acres of Land on the North side of Toppenny Creek and more or less bounded as follows to wit) Beginning at the Middle Stone to Lane Markle Brook &c Bridge thence over the Slough to a couple of marsh Trees and thence turning off as the Road goes to a branch called the Water Branch thence Down the Branch to the Creek to him and to his heirs for ever.

Item I give and Devise unto my Grandson George North, son of George North, all the remaining Part of my Land in Sussex County Situate & being in the Parish of Toppenny and the Creek and containing two hundred and Seventy Acres to him and to his heirs for ever Likewise Forty Shillings in Money.
