In the Name of God Amen May 20th 1761.

I John Juby of Surrogate County being of sound & disposing mind and Memory thanks be to God for the same do make, ordain constitute & appoint this my last Will and Testament in Manner following, that is to say. I Inheritious Give and Bequeath unto my loving W^{ife} Mary Juby my Land and Plantation whereon I now live containing fifteen hundred & fifteen Acres during her Widowhood or natural life. I also give to my said W^{ife} during her natural life my Negroes James Beck & great Oth and so her devise it is my Will that these said Negroes and their Increase shall be Provided between my Sons John & William my Daughter Anne and the Child with which

my Wife is now envious.

Item I Give & Devise unto my Son John Joby and to his Heirs and assigns forever after my decease or Marriage which ever first shall happen twelve hundred and sixteen Acres of Land (including the House Involves in and adjoining thereto being) part of the Tract of Land before given to my Wife but in case my said Son John should die before he comes to the Age of twenty one years and without Issue that it is my Will and desire that the Land and Plantations hereby given him shall go and remain to the Child next which my Wife is now big in case it is a Son to his Heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give and Devise unto my Son William Joby and to his Heirs and assigns forever my Tract of Land in the County of Prince George containing by Estimation three Hundred & eighty three Acres & in case he shall die before he arrives to the Age of twenty one years without issue then I give the said Land to the Child next which my Wife is now big in case it is a Son and to its Heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give and Devise unto the Child next which my Wife is now big and to its Heirs and assigns forever in case it is a Son the Land Spurchased of Edmund Barrow containing one hundred and fifty Acres adjoining the Tract whereon I live together with two hundred Acres of Land purchased of Hunters Trifles adjoining thereto and three Hundred Acres of Land after my Wife's decease or marriage out of the Tract above in adjoining to Barrow's Land aforesaid to be laid off by my Executors herein after named the Survivors or Survivor of them not running below the head of the Kid's Creek to complete the same.

Item It is my Will and desire that my dearest Man Ned shall be paid by my Executors herein after named or the Survivors or Survivor of them for the debt that can be got for him of the Money arising from the Sale of him I Give and Bequeath to the Child next which my Wife is now big in case it is a Son but in case it is a daughter then it is my Will that the said Money shall be divided amongst all my Children now a being & her in equal proportions.

Item I Give and Bequeath unto my Sons John & William, my Daughter Anne of the ^{child} with which my Wife is now envious and to their Heirs & assigns twenty two negroes to wit, Will, Henry, Titus, Thomas, Little Sam, Henry Job, Sall, Jack, Frick, Isack, Sam, Roger, (Arday) Lucy, Nelly, Princy, Lydia, David, Peg, Jacob & Lettice and their increase to be impregnated by my Wife Mary Joby as she thinks proper for the maintenance & Education of my said Children until my said Son shall attain to the Age of twenty years, if she continues a Widow or long, and then it is my Will that the said Negroes and their Increase shall be equally divided amongst all my said Children by my Executors herein after named the Survivors or Survivor of them. And if either or any of my said Children shall die before a Division of the said Negroes as aforesaid leaving Issue my desire is that his her or their share shall go to his her or their Issue and in case either of them shall die under eighteen years of Age without Issue then it is my Will that his, her or their share of the said Negroes shall be divided amongst the surviving Children to be equally divided between them as aforesaid. And if it should so happen that my said Wife should marry or die before my said Son John shall come to the Age of twenty years then it is my Will & desire that the said Negroes & their Increase shall be divided between my said Children in manner aforesaid by my Executors or the Survivor of them.

Item All the rest and residue of my Estate of what Nature or Quality so ever I Give in any manner in possession of my being I Give with a Provision is made of my Negroes amongst my Children in manner aforesaid of their said of one fifth part of the Money arising from the Sale here of I Give to my Wife and the rest to be equally divided amongst all my aforesaid Children the Child next which my Wife is now envious.

And I Give to my Executors may not be appointed and do constitute if appointed my Friends John Cunniff & Richard White Executors of this my last Will and Testament to return I Give the Guardianship of all my said during their Minority I Give to Mr. White who I have known and my Friend & my said on that Day and your just matter.
