but of perfect mind and Memory, Thanks be given to God, I do make and Ordain this my last

Plantation during her life or Widowhood and then to my Son as aforesaid.

I do give and bequeath unto my Son John Mose ten pound.

I do give and bequeath unto my Son Henry Mose ten pound.

I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Mose ten pound.

I do give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Mose ten pound.

I have My Will and devise is that my Wife shall have the use of my Slave named Dick and all the rest of my Personal Estate during her life or widowhood, and then to be equally divided between my five youngest Children (to wit) William John, Henry, Lucy and Elizabeth Mose, to them and their Heirs. My Will is that my son Benjamin Mose and my Wife Mary shall be Executors of this my last Will and Testament Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this twenty fifth day of September in the Year of Our Lord one thousand seven Hundred and sixty.
