In the name of god Amen I Mary Randolph of Surrey County being very Sick and weak in Body but in perfect and Sound Memory Shaking to & fro but calling to mind the Mortality of this Life and knowing it is appointed for all from our own to Die I do constitute and Appoint this to be my Last Will and Testament Causing all other Wills by me Made to be Void and of None Effect and first I resign my Soul into the hand of almighty god hoping for pardon of all my Sins and my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in a Christian and a Decent like Manner According to the Discretion of my Executor here after named and as for my worldly Goods I give and Dispose of them in Manner as followeth.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca Randolph all my Estate both Real and Personal but in what sort or manner to be sold for money by my Executor and the Money to produce at Interest till she comes of the Age of twenty one years or Married and if my Daughter dies ~~xxxx~~ without and then lawfully Begotten of her Body then my then my Estate to be Equally Divided Amongst my Brothers which as and I leave my said Daughter Rebecca to Joseph King to take Care of & bring her up till she shall come of Age or Married and I Make Joseph King my whole and sole Executor to fulfill this my Last will and Testament I Witness hereof I have Set my hand and seal this eighth of March one thousand seven hundred and fifty three.

In the Name of God Amen I Robert Wynne of the parish of Albemarle in the County of Sussex being of full Age but of perfect Senile Sound Memory & disposing of my mind & as I am this my Last Will & Testament Believing as becomes a Christian Bequeath my Soul unto God my Body I Desire may be Buried in a Decent & Christlike manner according to the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Mentioned That my Executors as pleased God to bestow upon Me; after my Debts & Funeral Charges are paid Dispose of in Manner and form Following

Item I Give & Bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary upon Condition that she discharge all the Debts & Incumbrances she was under before our Interment & give the said Negro Man called Belley & my Girl called Sarah (Duningtons Natural Life & the Use of my Negro Boy called Belley untill my Grandson Robert Wynne's Heir shall attain the age of Twenty one year & also I Give unto my wife my Bay Horse Branded with an Hurd & Ten pounds Cash & my two wheel Chair

Item I Devise to my Grand Daughter Mary Butler & to the Heirs of her body fully possessed forever the Land Plantation whereon I now live with all the Appurtenances belonging and the Profits of such I Give & Devise the same & the said Plantation to my Grandson Joel Tucker & to his Heirs forever also I Will & Desire that my Grandson Joel Tucker have the Use & Occupation my said Plantation & receive the profits thereof to his own Use untill my Grand Daughter shall marry or attain the Age of Twenty one year

Item I Give to my Son in law Joseph Tucker & Servetia his wife my Negro Man Bristol also one Negro woman now in their Possession called Diana

Item I Give unto my son in law Matthew Stanham & his Wife Martha one Negro woman now in their Possession called Anne & also my Negro woman called Peter
