

February Court 1762

In the name of God Amen Richard Blow of the Parish of
 Albemarle in the County of Sussex, do make this my last Will and Testament in
 manner following, to wit,

- Item* I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Richard Blow Son of Richard Blow deceased
 two Hundred and forty Acres Land lying on the South side of the Rother River in the County
 of Southampton, to him and his Heirs forever, Also the Sum of twenty pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give and bequeath unto my Son Henry Blow five Hundred Acres Land whereon he now
 lives lying on the North side of the Ditchwood Swamp to him and his Heirs forever.
 Also twenty pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give unto my Grandchildren Thomas & Mary Blunt five pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give unto my Son Samuel Blow twenty pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give unto my Son in Law Sam Henry Thomas five pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give unto my Daughter James Exton my Negro Man Jeffry, Also the Sum of twenty pounds
 Current Money, to her and her Heirs forever.
- Item* I give unto my Son in Law Micajah Edwards five pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give unto my Daughter Rebecca Marget one Negro girl known by the Name of Bath, Also
 twenty pounds Current Money, also my Riding Horse.
- Item* I give unto my Son John Blow all my Stock of Cattle, that he hath of mine in his Care on
 the Plantation in Carolina whereon he now lives, also twenty pounds Current Money.
- Item* I give and bequeath unto my Son Michael Blow and his Heirs forever, the Plantation
 whereon I now live with all my Lands adjoining the same Also three Negroes, Simon
 Jerry & Ned.
- Item* My Will is that after my just debts & Legacies are paid all the Remainder of my Estate
 of what Nature so ever, I give to my Son Michael Blow and his Heirs forever. And
 I do hereby appoint my Son Michael Blow my Sole Executor of this my last
 Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal
 this third day of September 1761.
