This Writing was presented in Court as the Men Captive Will of Sarah Evans, and thereupon Thomas Moore the elder, and Thomas Moore the younger were sworn & examined in support of the same and first Thomas Moore the elder saith that he heard the said Sarah Evans say all who had or should have intended for her daughter Ann, and the said Thomas Moore the younger saith that he heard the said Sarah often & often before and in her last sickness of which she died, say that all who had or should have intended to her daughter Ann and desired the Defendant to take notice of it and that in consequence thereof he committed to Writing the said Will now produced, whereupon after Mature Deliberation the said Writing is by the Court established as the Men Captive Will of the said Sarah Evans, and as such is ordered to be Recorded
