in the County of Sussex being aged and infirm; but of perfect sound and disposing
Sense and Memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament and
first of all bequeath my Soul unto God, hoping at the general Resurrection to have
that He united to my Body and with both to enter into eternal Happiness purchased
by my dear Redeemer Jesus Christ, through whose Merits alone I hope for Salvation.
my Body I desire may be buried in a Christian like manner, according to the direction
of my Executors hereafter mentioned. and as touching what the Holy Godd in His
pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me, I thus Dispose of, in manner and to the
persons following. VIZ. after my debts and Funeral charges are paid.

First I give unto my Son George Ezell two Hundred and ten Acres of Land be it more or
less, lying and being on a Branch of the Poplar Swamp called and known by the
Name of the Sighwood Branch in the County of Sussex, to him and his Heirs forever.

Also I give and bequeath unto my Daughters, Lydia Ezell one Feather bed & furniture as it
now stands; also a sheet weaving Loom with all its Appurtenances, one spinning Wheel
and Card, & one leather Sundial.

Also I give unto my Son Timothy Ezell, one large Iron Pot.

Also I give unto my Son, Thomas Ezell, all my Cooper's Tools; to my Son John Ezell, all my wearing
Apparel; and also to each of my said Sons Thomas and John, and to John Elbert, the several
Debts which each of them respectively owes to me.

Also I give unto my Son George Ezell, one half of my estate, of what kind soever not bequeathed to
Bequeathed.

Also I give unto my Wife Mary, during her natural life the use of the other half of my Estate
and after her decease my Will is that that half of my Estate the use whereof is hereby given
to my Wife, may be equally divided amongst my Daughters, Elizabeth Elbert, Lydia Ezell
and Mary Brod.

Lastly I do appoint my Son George Ezell Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In
Witness whereof I have set my hand & affix my Seal this Day of In the
Year of Our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and fifty nine.

Item My Will and Desire, that my Estate be not Appraised.

Mason Executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking all former Wills and
