to be divided betwixt my said son Richard Milneson — executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making Void all wills and Testaments

by me formerly made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty second day of February one thousand seven hundred and fifty eight.
