I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Anna Owen the use of my negro fellow named Quire during her widowhood & if she should marry then for the said negro to be sold and the money to be laid up for my two sons John & William and I give to my two sons John & William a Gun a piece and I give to my beloved Wife Anna Owen all my stock such as Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and Hens and all my meat & pease and I give to her also all my household goods during her widowhood and if she should marry then for all the household goods to be divided amongst my six Daughters and I give to my wife Anna Owen all my Lumber such as axes & poves and the right of this lease of Land whereon I now live and I do leave my wife Anna Owen and her brother Ambrose Griggs and whole & sole Executors of this my last will & testament revoking and annulling all other wills made by me With my Hand & Seal this twenty seventh Day of November one thousand seven hundred and sixty two
