

Anno Regni Decimo Georgii Tertii Regis (237)

In the Name of God Amen, this Fourteenth Day of November one thousand seven hundred and seventy nine. I Burd Blary of Sussex County being weak of Body but of perfect mind & Memory thanks to almighty God — Do make this my last will & Testament. — First I Recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God, &c. &c. —

Itemth I Give to my wife Elizabeth Blary the Labour of my two Negroes Viz. Ambra & Hannah During her natural life; likewise my plantation where on I now live with all my stock of Cattle &c. let it be in what kind soever, also one feather Bed & furniture, one Iron pot & frying pan four pewter Dishes & eight pewter plates, one Spinning Wheel & cards, all During her life.

Itemth I Give & bequeath to my son John Blary my land & plantation where on I now live of the two Negroes before named — Ambra & Hannah at the Deces of his mother, to him and his heirs for ever.

Itemth I Give and bequeath to my son James Blary my four hundred Acres of Land Bought of Thomas Myas to him & his heirs for ever likewise one Negro woman Named Nan also my Desk and Corner cupboard and walnut Table. And that feather Bed at his grandmother's at her decease.

Itemth I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Ann Blary my green Chest also my Desire is she shall have my part of her Grandmother's Plate when it would belong to me the Bed only Excepted to James.

Itemth I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Blary two Negroes Viz. Lucy & Will, to her and her heirs for ever, and my Bed & furniture I now lie on, also two Bags Bandletticks and my Tea Table one large Iron pot four New pewter Dishes. —

Itemth I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Blary one Negro Girl Named Hannah to her and her heirs for ever. —

Itemth I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Silviah Blary one Negro Girl Named Rachel to her and her heirs for ever.

Itemth I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Mourning Blary one Negro Girl Named Cherry.

Itemth I Desire my son James should have my Gun.

Itemth My will and Desire is, that if either of my Children should Die, before they come to the age of Twenty one years then their part to be Equally Divided amongst the survivors then living and likewise what I have left to my wife and have not given to my son John at her Death I Desire should be Equally Divided amongst all my Children then living — further I Desire my family to be kept Together and every Child to receive what I have left them as fast as they come to the age of Twenty one years.
